Giving every child a stronger start



Classroom Support Programme (CSP)

Preparing Children for Primary School

Through small-group learning, Learning Facilitators work with preschool teachers to provide in-class support for children requiring assistance in language, literacy and numeracy.

A study by the National Institute of Education found that CSP children's learning gaps can narrow, with many catching up to the national norm of Singapore.



You've Got Talent Programme (YGT)

Nurturing Holistic Development

Empowering every child to discover their spark.

YGT gives children from low-income families opportunities to explore their interests, learn new skills, and build confidence through enrichment, from arts to sports. This helps every child to discover their unique talents.



Development Support Specialist (DSS) Programme

Supporting Inclusive Classrooms

Helping every child to learn and thrive together.

DSS programme provides guidance and practical support to teachers and families, ensuring children that require additional developmental support can learn, grow, and participate confidently with their peers.
